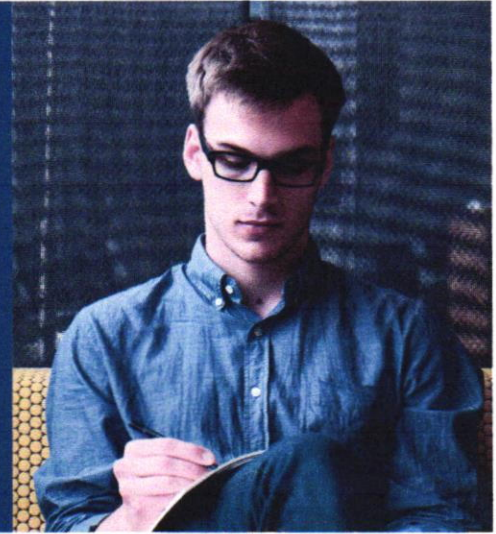

Winter Preparation continued...

Do you have any vehicle, camper or other item on City right of way? The city will be stepping up enforcement this fall in order to make snow removal safer and more efficient.

If you need assistance clearing city right of way, please call city hall!

When there is snowfall significant enough to roll out snow plows, there will be a post on the City Facebook page announcing a snow alert. When this happens, **ALL VEHICLES MUST BE REMOVED FROM CITY RIGHT OF WAYS!** Failure to do so may result in fines, and or towing at the owner's expense.

Roberts Food Bank

The Roberts Foodbank distributes food to those in need every 4th Tuesday of each month.

Distribution begins at 1:00 P.M. behind the Mustang Events Center. It is a drive through operation.

You must be in line at 1:00 to be eligible.

Distribution is done by household.

A member of a household must be present to receive assistance.

Persons who are physically unable to come, may call city hall to see if they qualify for an exception.

The food bank is run by volunteers, with the backing of The City of Roberts, The Idaho Food Bank, The Alliance for the Greater Roberts area and many other donors.
